PATIENT'S RIGHTS

These are your rights as a client. Any individual who received services in the State of New Jersey has rights guaranteed by the law of the State of New Jersey and the laws of the United States. Certain rights cannot be limited. Other rights may be limited by statute, regulation, and court decision appropriate to your situation.

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO:

1. The right to privacy and dignity.
2. Reasonable access to care, regardless of race religion, gender, sexual orientation, ethnicity, age or disability.
3. Confidentiality concerning health information as outlined in the Notice of Privacy.
4. A safe, sanitary and humane environment.
5. Involvement of family members and/or significant others when appropriate in facilitating service decisions.
6. Receive adequate information about the staff responsible for your care.
7. Ample opportunity to meet with staff.
8. An individualized service plan with periodic review.
9. Prompt referral for physical treatment of any physical ailment.
10. Freedom to refuse services unless services are required by law or court order.
11. Participate in the consideration of ethical issues that arise n the provision of care and services.
12. Communicate in your predominate language or with a certified interpreter if you are hearing or visually impaired.
13. Designate a surrogate decision-maker if you are unable to understand the proposed services.
14. Terminate your services unless service is mandated by the court.
15. Be fully informed of your Rights, Responsibilities and Program rules.
16. Ample opportunity to review and comment on the policies and procedures of JSF Professional Counseling Services.
17. The right to not be subjected to non-standard treatment or procedures, experimental procedures or research, psycho-surgery, sterilization, electro-convulsive therapy or provider demonstration programs, without written informed consent, after consultation with counsel or interested party of the client's choice (see NJAC, 10:37-6, Article XV).
 - i) If a client has been adjudicated incompetent, authorization for such procedures may be obtained only pursuant to the requirements of NJSA 30:4-24.2(d)2.
